Farm Service Agency, FSA, Action/Programs

- FSA Personal have filed Loss Assessment Reports with the State FSA Office on the affected areas.
- FSA is accepting Acreage Reports right now and these can be used by the Crop Insurance Agent or Adjuster to assist in the Claim Process.
- FSA is also accepting Failed Acreage Reports for land that was planted to Corn and it is being planted to another Crop. If Corn or Soybeans are being replanted to the SAME Crop, FSA will just need to know the LAST planting date.
- FSA DOES NOT have a Disaster Program going on at this time. There also is not a 2014 SURE Program either.
- FSA has a Livestock Disaster Program going on at this time. If you have livestock affected by last weeks storm, you need to contact the FSA Office and discuss the record keeping process to apply for a Livestock Indemnity Payment.
- FSA also is currently taking applications for producers that had Cattle/Livestock on Grazing Land in 2012. There is a Disaster Payment available to Eligible Producers that had Cattle/Livestock on Grazing Land in 2012. Contact the Office for more information.
- FSA has Emergency Loan Programs Available to Eligible Producers.
